A second career pastor, she graduated from college with a B.S. in Music Education and taught music in the Mount Union (PA) schools; she also served for many years as Director of Music at St. Luke Lutheran Church, Mount Union. Prior to attending seminary, she took training as a lay worship leader in the Lutheran Church and served as a supply worship leader in a number of congregations. Having graduated from the Lutheran Theological Seminary/Gettysburg in 1993, she was called and ordained in 1994 as the pastor of Mount Zion Lutheran Church, Glasgow, Pennsylvania.
